An estimated 60,825 firefighter injuries occurred in the line of duty in 2019, an increase of four percent over the 2018 injury total. In 2019, an estimated 15,350 collisions involved fire department emergency vehicles responding to or returning from incidents. In addition to injuries, there were 7,675 documented exposures to infectious diseases and 24,525 exposures to hazardous conditions.

More than 60,000 law enforcement officers were assaulted in the line of duty in 2020, including more than 40 who were killed, according to the FBI. The total of 60,105 was an increase of 4,071 from 2019, with FBI drawing on reports from some 9,895 law enforcement agencies
