His injuries included traumatic brain injury, multiple strokes, several cervical/thoracic spine fractures, respiratory failure, and other injuries.

He worked with physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy six days a week. He progressed rapidly – defying all odds – because at one point doctors were not sure he would survive.
