Admitting Diagnosis: Status Post COVID-19

Length of Stay: 6 Days

Discharge Location: Home with Outpatient

Mr. Vince Starks was working full time in Houston until he woke up on March 31st with dizziness and shortness of breath. He had his brother take him to the nearest ER and from there he was intubated, placed in the ICU, and placed in a medically induced coma for eight days. While in a hospital in Houston, he was diagnosed with COVID-19 and stayed in Houston until April 16th when he was transferred to Victoria Post Acute Medical Long Term Acute Care Hospital. Upon discharge from the Houston facility, staff cheered him on because he was the second person to leave that hospital alive with the COVID-19 diagnosis. Mr. Starks stayed at the Victoria Post Acute Medical Long Term Acute Care Hospital for eleven days before finally transferring to Post Acute Medical Rehabilitation of Victoria. Upon admission, he required set-up assistance with activities of daily living, transfers, and ambulation using a rolling walker. With his motivation to see family again and return home to Houston, he exceeded all goals set and became independent will all activities and ambulation with no assistive device. Mr. Starks would like to "get healthy again and go back to work full time." He states the employees "have been amazing" and he enjoyed his time here. He reports "the spirit and attitude make me feel comfortable here and you can tell the employees love their jobs."
